

“The Obvious Answer” Instructions

The Concept: The players will be given a trivia question and they have to figure out if the obvious answer is the correct one.

Items Needed: Worksheet (included as separate PDF file).

Instructions: You can split your group into teams or have them play as individuals. Teams can make the game fun because the groups have to decide together on an answer. Before starting the game, hand out the worksheet so the teams or single players can circle their answers as the questions come up on the screen.

The game starts out by making the players believe that it will be a very simple quiz where the obvious answer will be correct. After question 1, their dreams of an easy quiz are crushed and they realize the correct answer will not always be the most obvious one.

The players/teams will need to circle the correct answer on their worksheets when the questions appear. If your group is split into teams, make sure each team has circled their answer, and then have them advise the game leader what they think the answer is going to be before it is revealed. This way the entire group gets to know what the other teams thought the answer would be. If they are playing as individuals, you could have everyone vote by raising their hands to see which answer they thought it was going to be.

Scoring: One point for each correct answer. There’s a tiebreaker if any of the teams/individuals are tied after the last question. The closest to the correct answer is the winner.
