

“Water, Water Everywhere” Instructions

The Concept: The players have to guess which Bible story the quotes are from.

Items Needed: None

Instructions: This game can be done on an individual or team basis. A paraphrased quote from someone in the Bible will appear on the screen. The Bible story that the quote is from will have something to do with water (Peter walking on it, Jesus turning it into wine, etc.). The quotes are not from any particular version of the Bible and are paraphrased to be concise.

The players will have to determine which wet story the quote is from in order to get the points. You can be as strict as you want on how specific the answers need to be. It will depend on how well your kids know the stories. They may know that the quote about dipping 7 times in the river is from the story of a guy getting healed from leprosy, but they may not know Naaman's name or that it was Elisha that gave him the instructions.

When a team/person has the answer, it's up to you how you have them show you they know it. You could have them raise their hand, stand up, run to the front, take off their shoes and socks and clap their feet together, or whatever you want.

Scoring: One point for each correct answer. There's a tiebreaker if any of the teams/individuals are tied after the last question. The tiebreaker question is “In the NT, how many times does Jesus say the word ‘water’?” If you want to explain it further to the group, have them imagine reading the entire New Testament from Matthew through to Revelation. How many times will the word “water” be printed in red (i.e., spoken by Jesus). Even if the word appears in a story repeated in more than one of the Gospels, you would count it each time.
