

“Tourney Time: Fast Food Fight” Instructions

The Concept: The players will fill out a tournament bracket to determine which of the fast food restaurants in the competition is the oldest.

Items Needed: Tournament handout (included as a separate PDF file)

Instructions: This is an individual game. Print out the blank brackets and pass them out to the group. After a brief introduction, the fast food joints competing are shown. The eighth slide will tell you to take a minute to fill out the bracket. At this point, stop and wait for the group to complete their sheets. Once your group has finished filling out the bracket, continue on with the game. You may want to have some of your leaders/counselors walk around the group to make sure the brackets have been filled out. If anyone is trying to cheat, call the cops immediately. A night in a cold cell should teach them a lesson.

The game will show face offs between each of the fast food places for each round (sweet sixteen, elite eight, final four, and the championship). After each round, an updated bracket is shown so the group can check their answers and catch up if they fell behind.

There are three screens at the end of the game that show a timeline with the years the restaurants were opened. You can show these if you think your group will be interested in the order they came on the scene.

Scoring: You can score it anyway you want. You may just want to give one point for each right answer for the whole bracket. Another way to score it is one point for each correct answer in the sweet sixteen round, two points for the elite eight, three points for the final four, and four points for picking the champion.
