Ever met a mom who somehow keeps the world spinning, keeps growing even in chaos, and keeps pouring into others? It's not magic. It's strategy.

And the more I've studied Scripture and watched the lives of fruitful moms, the more I've realized something:

God wants all of us—not just moms—to live successful lives.

We're all looking for a life that matters. A life that lasts. A life that leaves a mark.

But the people who do that don't always look like rock stars or influencers.

More often than not, they look like your mom, your grandma, or a faithful servant behind the scenes.

They've learned to live fruitfully—and fruitfulness isn't an accident. It's built on God's strategy.

If only God has written these strategies down so that we could read them...

## The Original Blueprint: Genesis 1:28

“God blessed them and said to them, ‘Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it...’”

This was God’s *very first command* to humanity. Before the fall. Before sin. Before the IRS.

He wasn’t just telling Adam and Eve to have kids—He was saying:

“Use what I gave you to create something beautiful and lasting.”

Be fruitful isn’t a one-time thing.

It’s God’s ongoing call to every believer—and moms just happen to give us the best example.

**THE 3 SECRET STRATEGIES OF SUCCESSFUL MOMS (AND FRUITFUL PEOPLE)**

# 1. MOMS MANAGE (Steward)

A Big Bible Word for Manage is to Steward... to properly and effective use what you have been given.

God has given us so much? Can God trust us to use it properly and be fruitful?

**Luke 16:10 – “Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much...”**

If we can be trusted with a little, we will be trusted with a lot.

Fruitful moms are stewards, not owners. They take what God gave—time, energy, influence, people—and manage it with purpose.

Fruitful people don't just drift—they decide.

## **KEY QUESTION:**

**Am I living like what I've been given matters to God?**

## 2. MOMS MATURE – Keep Growing, Even When It's Hard

I saw my wife, Sarah learn so much when she had our first son 15 years ago. I remember being amazed...

I am still amazed, because she is still learning, and growing. She is even a better mom today...

James 1:4 – “Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.”

Moms grow through pain. They evolve. They adapt. They press on.

Fruitful people refuse to stop growing. They're not “finished products”—they're in process, getting better each season.

### KEY TRUTH:

Maturity doesn't come with age. It comes with intentional growth.

### 3. MOMS MULTIPLY – Pass It On to Others

There is a Big Bible Word for this –  
Discipleship!

Moms disciple. They shape souls. They multiply peace, wisdom, and character in others.

And that's the *same calling* for every believer.

The Apostle Paul wrote the following to a young minister named Timothy...

2 Timothy 1:5 "I am reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also."

Grandmother Lois multiplied her faith...

Mother Eunice multiplied her faith...

Now we see it in Timothy.

Moms Multiply!

Fruitful people live with legacy in mind—  
not just to do lists.

But here's the key:

**Every farmer knows... Fruitfulness only comes when you're connected to the Vine.**

John 15:5 – “I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit...”

Apart from Jesus, it's all pressure.

With Him? It becomes **purpose**.

Imagine a whole church full of fruitful people—men, women, parents, singles—All managing well, maturing daily, and multiplying life in others.

Let's become that church.

Let's do something with this today.

Here are 3 Calls to Action.

## **Call to Action**

### **#1: Choose One Area to Strengthen This Week**

Are you managing, maturing, or multiplying?

Pick the area where you're weakest—and take one intentional step this week to grow stronger.

Whether that's organizing your time better, investing in personal growth, or pouring into someone else—choose it and act on it.

### **#2: Thank the Fruitful People Who've Impacted You**

Text, call, or message the moms, mentors, or spiritual leaders who've multiplied their faith into your life.

Tell them how their fruitfulness has shaped

you—and if possible, **pass it forward** to someone else this week.

### **#3: Pray and Worship—Ask God to Make You Fruitful**

John 15:5 says you can't bear fruit unless you stay connected to Jesus.

Take time today to **worship, pray, and surrender your life to God's hands.**

Ask Him to make you **a fruitful person**—someone who manages well, keeps maturing, and multiplies life into others.
