What is worship?

A church service?

Music?

Psalm 96 commands us to worship.

3 things stand out in this passage and are echoed in the familiar story of Moses and the burning bush.

Glory

Ascribe to the Lord the GLORY due His name.

Worship is about who receives the glory, and their worthiness to receive it.

Moses saw a burning bush...

This bush brought glory to one... God.

Worship falls fort when it is about the singer, the preacher, the church facility, or the denomination.

We worship the one who is most worthy of our worship & praise. We try to give Him the glory due His name.

Beauty

Worship is beautiful.

It only makes sense that worship would be beautiful, because we are worshiping the most beautiful loving creator.

Our scripture passage commands us to worship the Lord in SPLENDOR/Beauty.

“Beautiful to who?” Beautiful to God!

Moses saw a beauty in the burning bush.

NOT CONSUMED

You ought to feel better after worshipping...

Worship is glorious, beautiful...

Holy

Our scripture commanded us to worship the Lord in the splendor of holiness.

Holy means devoted or “set apart” for one purpose.

We should have a worship that is only for Jesus! Like no one else.

Reverence..

Sing..

Give..

Serve..

When Moses saw the burning bush, he was drawn to it. As Moses drew close to it He was commanded “take off your shoes for you are standing on holy ground.”

We worship a Holy God.

His presence changes us.

Worship is glorious, beautiful, and holy.

Song

Our worship should be a burning bush.

Glorious... exalting God alone.

Beautiful... Not consumed.

Holy... set apart and changing us.

The burning bush caused Moses to “turn
aside.”

Go check it out... Moses.

Our worship should cause others to turn
aside and check out Jesus.
